

## What are the goals of the Penny Referendum?

- To raise \$120M for the following corridor projects:
  - \$80M for traffic improvements and bridge reconstruction on US278 near Hilton Head Island
  - \$30M for corridor improvements on US21 on Lady's Island
  - \$10M for the installation of sidewalks and pathways throughout the county

SCDOR sends a quarterly check to Beaufort County




#### What items are exempt?

- A general rule of thumb is that anything exempt from the state's 6% sales and use tax, is also exempt from the penny tax.
