ATTENDANCE POLICY

Attendance at both retreats is **mandatory**. Participants cannot miss more than one monthly session and successfully complete the program. (But may make up sessions in a subsequent year) Sessions *typically* last from 8 am to 5 pm. Participants are expected to attend the **entire** day's session, including **lunch**.

SELECTION CRITERIA

We are looking for a diverse group in hopes of reflecting the population of the greater Beaufort area. This would include a variety of age groups, cultures, men and women, persons new to the area as well as long-time residents, different professions, etc. If someone is not chosen as a participant in this year's class, they are encouraged to reapply in another year. Applicant interviews will be held during the month of June, with the class anticipated to be announced by July 2024

Several alternates will be chosen and are quite often placed closer to the September retreat. **No alternates** will be placed after the first retreat.
